The State of Florida requires both immigration documents and residency documents to establish Florida residency for tuition purposes.

- **U.S. Immigration Documents** - Students
- **Florida Residency Documents - Minimum of two Florida documents required**

dated one year before the first day of the term. At least one of the documents submitted must be from the first group.

No single piece of evidence shall be conclusive.

Dependent Status - Students under 24 years.

Independent Status - Students age 24 and over. Students who claim to be “independent” and are under the age of 24 must provide documents supporting claim.
